### INDIVIDUAL RECALL

Make 1 sound signal and raise INDIVIDUAL RECALL flag to half-mast. When Individual has started correctly lower INDIVIDUAL RECALL flag

### **GENERAL RECALL**

- 1. Make 2 sound signals and raise GENERAL RECALL flag.
- Lower ALL other flags completely.
  To end general recall, make 1 sound signal and lower GENERAL RECALL flag.

### RECOMMENCE THE STARTING SEQUENCE AFTER ONE MINUTE.

### **SHORTENED COURSE**

Raise the SHORTENED COURSE flag and raise the CLASS/S flag/s and make 2 sound signals for the leading boat in each class whose course is shortened. Do this as they round the last mark.

### **FINISHING**

Weather permitting, always finish a race at the top of a windward leg. Position the Committee Boat on the correct side of the finish mark, there is NO hooked finish. Raise the FINISH flag.

### **ABANDONMENT**

Make 3 sound signals and hoist the ABANDON flag.

### **POSTPONEMENT**

Make 2 sound signals and hoist POSTPONEMENT FLAG

To end postponement: Make 1 sound signal and lower POSTPONEMENT FLAG.

Then restart the starting sequence after one minute.




## Race Signals

The meanings of visual and sound signals are stated below. An Arrow pointing up or down (▲ ▼) means that a visual signal is displayed or removed. A dot (.) means a sound; dots with dashes ( . -- - - . ) mean repetitive sounds. When a visual signal is displayed over a class flag, the signal applies only to that class.

### POSTPONEMENT SIGNALS



AP Races not started are postponed. The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal unless at that time the race is postponed again. or abandaned.



AP Races not started are postponed. Further signals ashore.



AP over A Races not started are postponed. No more racing today.

A-P over a numeral pennant 1-6.

Postponement of 1-6 hours from the scheduled starting time.

### ABANDONMENT SIGNALS



N All races that have started are abandoned. Return to the starting area. The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal unless at that time the race is abandoned again or postponed.





N over H All races are abandoned. Further signals ashore.





N over A All races are abandoned. No more racing today.

### RECALL SIGNALS



Individual recall.



First Substitute. General recall. The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal.

### SIGNALS BEFORE THE START



P Preparatory signal.



Rule 30.1 is in effect.



Rule 30.2 is in effect.



Black Flag. Rule 30.3 is in effect.

### COURSE CHANGE



S No later than the warning signal: Sail the short course. At a rounding or finishing mark: Finish between the nearby mark and the staff displaying this flag.



position of the next mark has been changed.

OTHER SIGNALS

Ashore: A notice to competitors has been posted. Afloat: Come within hail or follow this boat



The object displaying this signal replaces a missing mark.



Wear personal buoyancy



(no sound) Blue flag or shape. This race committee boat is in position at the finishing line.
